NAIROBI

On arrival in Nairobi, transfer to our accommodation for a 2 night stay. This evening we gather for a welcome dinner. (D) **Day 2:** Today we explore some of Nairobi's highlights: Daphne Sheldrick's Elephant Orphanage, the Giraffe Centre, Karen Blixen Museum and the Kazuri Bead Factory with a salivating lunch at the famous Carnivore Restaurant. (L)

Overnight: The Boma or similar (B daily)

➔ Days 3 to 5

NAIROBI TO AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

We leave the city behind and drive to Amboseli National Park for a 3 night stay, arriving in time for check in and lunch. Enjoy an afternoon game drive before returning to the lodge around dusk. **Days 4 and 5** are ours to explore this beautiful park at the foot of Mt Kilimanjaro.

Overnight: Oltukai Lodge or similar (B,L,D daily)

➔ Days 6 and 7

AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK TO NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

We farewell Amboseli and make our way to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, stopping at the Kenya/Tanzania border at Namanga to clear immigration and customs formalities and meet our Tanzanian driver guide. After changing vehicles we make our way to Arusha for lunch before continuing to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area for our 2 night stay. **Day 7** sees us descend to the Crater floor to explore the largest unbroken and un-flooded caldera on earth, home to the densest population of lions worldwide. Enjoy a picnic lunch in the Crater, returning to our lodge for dinner.

Overnight: Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge or similar (B,L,D daily)

➔ Days 8 and 9

NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA TO SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

An early start along the crater rim takes us to Olduvai Gorge and on to Serengeti National Park, arriving in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive. **Day 9:** We set out to explore the Serengeti, home to the Big Cats.

Overnight: Serengeti Sopa Lodge or similar (B,L,D daily)

➔ Days 10 to 12

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK TO MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

We transfer to the Masai Mara via the Kenya/Tanzania Border at Isebania to clear immigration and Customs formalities enjoying a picnic lunch along the way, arriving at our Lodge in time for dinner. **Days 11 and 12** are spent on extended game drives exploring the Reserve, keeping an eye out for some of the millions of antelope, wildebeest and zebras crossing the Mara River as part of the spectacular annual Great Migration. We visit a local Masai village and learn about their way of life. Enjoy an optional early morning hot air balloon ride floating over the African Plains (must be pre- booked)

Overnight: Ashnil Mara Tented Camp or similar (B,L,D daily)

➔ Days 13 and 14

MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE TO LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Our drive today takes us to the Great Rift Valley. We arrive in Nakuru Town in time for check in and lunch. Lake Nakuru is one of the famous soda lakes in the region, the park is home to an abundance of bird life. **Day 14:** We take an excursion to Lake Bogoria, home to hot water geysers and also one of the world's largest populations of lesser flamingoes.

Overnight: Sarova Woodlands Hotel or similar (B,L,D daily)

LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK TO NAIROBI

After a leisurely breakfast we return to Nairobi for an afternoon of leisure. This evening enjoy a dinner to farewell those who are leaving us tomorrow.

NAIROBI TO JOHANNESBURG

JOHANNESBURG TO CAPE TOWN

After breakfast we transfer to the airport and meet our guests on the 15 day Southern Africa Game Encounter. Our flight to Cape Town is included and on arrival we will be transferred to our home for the next 4 nights. The afternoon is yours to explore or relax before our dinner, welcoming us to this beautiful city.

Day 18: This morning we set off for a cable car ride up Table Mountain (weather permitting), before exploring Cape Town's highlights. Dinner tonight will be a true African Experience! KARONGWE GAME RESERVE TO SABI SANDS GAME RESERVE

Day 24: After an early morning game activity and breakfast we transfer via the scenic Panorama Route to Sabi Sands Game Reserve, including a stop at the 3rd largest canyon in the world: Blyde River Canyon. Lunch is included. **Days 25 and 26** are for exploring the Sabi Sands reserve and observing the different bio diversity of this area on 2 game drives daily and an included optional bush walk (subject to availability and conditions).
